






A size that's right for you

Zero gravity tilt position



Farborg chair mechanisms achieve a NASA-inspired zero gravity tilt. The "Zero-G" posture was invented by NASA. When astronauts prepare to launch, they recline into this neutral position to equalize the pressure they'll experience during rapid changes in gravitational force.

Zero gravity is where the legs and head are raised slightly above your heart, positioning your torso and legs so they form an angle of around 120 degrees.

As well as being really comfortable, 'zero gravity' provides a number of health benefits*:

- Improved circulation
- · Improved digestion
- Reduced swelling in the legs
- Reduced back pain

You can also have your legs up nice and high and still be in a comfortable position to interact with others in the room, watch your favorite show or do the crossword.






Guarantee
